Credit Hours:	The unit of credit is the semester hour. Two (2) clock hours of studio courses equals one (1) credit hour. One (1) clock hour of lecture courses per week equals one (1) credit hour.

Standard Full-Time Workload:	A full study load may vary between 12 and 18 credit hours per semester. KCAI requires that students take a minimum of 12 credit hours in order to maintain full-time student status. Students may choose to enroll in up to 18 credit hours, but no more than 15 credit hours are recommended. More than 12 credit hours of studio credit is not recommended. Students may add an art history or liberal arts course if 15 credit hours are needed.
