INSTITUTO ALLENDE

Our program's home base is the historic Instituto Allende, part of the University of Guanajuato.

The Instituto is housed in a former Carmelite convent, an expansive 18th-century compound of studios, galleries, classrooms, courtyards and gardens.



STUDIO ART PROGRAM

Students can pursue analog or digital mediums of their choice, in addition to studying traditional ceramics and fibers processes with local teachers.



SPANISH LANGUAGE CLASSES

Integral to the program's cultural immersion is 10 hours of Spanish instruction tailored to students' skill levels and taught by local faculty.



ORGANIZED DAY TRIPS

Day trips will take us to Cañada de la Virgen, a complex of Otomi pyramids built around 500 AD, and the state capital of Guanajuato, birthplace of artist Diego Rivera and once the richest city in the hemisphere.
